Classification of the substance or mixture

Acute Tox. 4; H302 + H312 + H332

Skin Irrit. 2; H315

Eye Irrit. 2; H319

Aquatic Acute 1; H400

Aquatic Chronic 1; H410



Warning

Hazards

Harmful if swallowed, in contact with skin or if inhaled. (H302 + H312 + H332)

Causes skin irritation. (H315)

Causes serious eye irritation. (H319)

Very toxic to aquatic life with long lasting effects. (H410)

General

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Prevention

Avoid breathing dust. (P261).

Wear protective gloves/protective clothing. (P280).

IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of protective gloves/protective clothing. (P302+P352).

If eye irritation persists: Get medical advice/attention. (P337+P313).

Call a POISON CENTER/doctor if you feel unwell. (P312).

Response**Storage**

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Disposal

Dispose of contents/container to an approved waste disposal plant. (P501).

Additional labelling

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Personal protective equipment

**Generally**

Use only CE marked protective equipment.

Respiratory equipment

Use in fumehood

Skin protection

Dedicated work clothing should be worn.

Hand protection

Recommended: Nitrile rubber. Breakthrough time: > 480 minutes (Class 6)

Eye protection

Wear safety glasses with side shields.
