## Hazards identification

**Classification of the substance or mixture**Skin Corr. 1A; H314  
Eye Dam. 1; H318  
; DGEBE**Danger****▼ Hazards**Causes severe skin burns and eye damage. (H314)  
Do not use in paint spraying equipment. (DGEBE)**General**-  
Do not breathe mist/vapours/fume/spray. (P260).**Prevention**

Wash hands/exposed areas/exposed skin/hands and exposed skin thoroughly after handling. (P264).

**▼ Safety statements**Wear eye protection/protective clothing/protective gloves. (P280).  
Immediately call a POISON CENTER/doctor. (P310).**Response**

IF SWALLOWED: Rinse mouth. Do NOT induce vomiting. (P301+P330+P331).

IF ON SKIN (or hair): Take off immediately all contaminated clothing. Rinse skin with water [or shower]. (P303+P361+P353).

IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. (P305+P351+P338).
