**Danger****Hazards**

Harmful if swallowed, in contact with skin or if inhaled. (H302 + H312 + H332)

Causes severe skin burns and eye damage. (H314)

May cause an allergic skin reaction. (H317)

May cause allergy or asthma symptoms or breathing difficulties if inhaled. (H334)

Harmful to aquatic life with long lasting effects. (H412)

Safety statements**General**

Prevention

Do not breathe dust. (P260).

Wear eye protection/protective clothing/protective gloves. (P280).

Call a POISON CENTER/doctor if you feel unwell. (P312).

Response

IF SWALLOWED: Rinse mouth. Do NOT induce vomiting. (P301+P330+P331).

IF ON SKIN (or hair): Take off immediately all contaminated clothing. Rinse skin with water [or shower]. (P303+P361+P353).

IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. (P305+P351+P338).

Personal protective equipment

**Generally**

Use only CE marked protective equipment.

Respiratory equipment

Skin protection

Dedicated work clothing should be worn. Wear a protective suit in the event of prolonged periods of work with the product.

Hand protection

Recommended: Nitrile rubber. Breakthrough time: > 480 minutes (Class 6)

Eye protection
