Danger

Hazards

Harmful if swallowed, in contact with skin or if inhaled. (H302 + H312 + H332)

Causes skin irritation. (H315)

Causes serious eye irritation. (H319)

May cause respiratory irritation. (H335)

Causes damage to organs through prolonged or repeated exposure. (H372)

Very toxic to aquatic life. (H400)

Safety statements

General

Prevention

Do not breathe dust. (P260).

Wear protective gloves/protective clothing. (P280).

Get medical advice/attention if you feel unwell. (P314).

Response

IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of protective gloves/protective clothing. (P302+P352).

IF INHALED: Remove person to fresh air and keep comfortable for breathing.

(P304+P340).

Personal protective equipment



Generally

Use only CE marked protective equipment.

Respiratory equipment

Use in fumehood

Skin protection

Dedicated work clothing should be worn. Wear a protective suit in the event of prolonged periods of work with the product.

Hand protection

Recommended: Nitrile rubber. Breakthrough time: > 480 minutes (Class 6)

Eye protection

Wear safety glasses with side shields.
